Instructions for Use



Description

The MPR Lateral Positioning Peg Board System is a device for positioning patients for hip sugeries, comprising an expandable Delrin® board with 373 sockets for inserting pegs, a radioluscent gel overlay, and a pair of clamps for securing the system to an operating table.

Four different varieties of the MPR Lateral Positioning Peg Board System are available, depending on preference. The base model (MPR-2100) comes with a set of 8 coated Delrin® pegs. However, variants that instead come with coated metal (MPR-2100-M), non-coated Delrin (MPR-2101-NCP), or non-coated metal pegs (MPR-2101-NCM) are also available. The peg sets are also available for purchase separately (see ACCESSORIES).

All components and accessories are latex-free.


Indications

For positioning of patient, primarily during hip-related procedures.

Instructions for Use

- 1. Place the MPR Lateral Hip Positioning Peg Board System either directly onto the surgical table, or on top of the table pad, depending on your facility's guidelines.
- 2. Secure the peg board with the two stabilizing clamps provided, placing one near the head of the table, and the other at the foot of the peg board on the opposite side of the table (see Figure 1). Secure and lock the clamps to the table rails with a blade-style clamp, such as the MPR Over-the-Rail Universal Clamp (MPR-ORUC) (see ACCESSORIES on page 1).
- 3. Place the gel overlay on the positioner (see Figure 2). A sheet (not shown) can be placed over the padding to help prevent shifting as the patient is transferred to the table.

POSITION PEGS ACCORDINGLY

- 4. Place a short peg in the sacral area (see Figure 3). Ensure that the peg is properly seated in the socket so that it does not come loose or pop out.
- 5. Place a long peg in the posterior thoracic region below the scapula (see Figure 3).
- 6. Place a short peg in front of the pubis (see Figure 4). Take care to avoid neuro-vascular structure compression in both femoral triangles.
- 7. Place a long peg directly below the pectoral muscle (see Figure 4). Be mindful of the need for adequate ventilation of this area.

NOTE: More pegs, as well as the use of peg extenders (*see ACCESSORIES on page 1*), may be required for larger patients.

Do not use board as a transport device.





Cleaning & Maintenance

PEG BOARD

- Scrub out any impacted material. Avoid using abrasive materials as they may scratch the board.
- 2. Clean using your facility's recommended antiseptic and tap water. Make sure to remove all residue.
- 3. Allow to air dry on a sheet of absorbent matting.

GEL OVERLAY*

- Wash the gel overlay with a pH-neutral detergent or enzyme solution according to your facility's protocol. Rinse any residue off thoroughly with clean tap water.
 NOTE: To reduce risk of tears, avoid using abrasive materials when cleaning.
- 2. Store either rolled up or flat. Be mindful that the gel will match its storage temperature.
- ▲ Do not sterilize the gel overlay. Keep away from high temperatures.

PEGS

- Clean pegs with your facility's recommended antiseptic and tap water. Make sure to remove all residue.
- 2. Uncoated metal pegs can also be cleaned using your facility's recommended aluminum detergent, according to the manufacturer's instructions, and then sterilized according to your facility's protocol.
- ▲ Do not use an autoclave to sterilize coated pegs.

*Also applies to gel peg wraps (see ADDITIONAL ACCESSORIES on page 4.)
